ARTICLE IV.—OFFICERS.

SEC. 1.—The officers of the Association shall officers. consist of a President, Vice-President, Recording Summary of Secretary, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Assistant Recording Secretary, and Sergeant-at-Arms; all of whom shall be elected by ballot at Election of the annual meeting.

SEC. 3.—No nomination shall be accepted unless the person nominated shall have signified Nomination his willingness to accept the office for which he is named, and no nomination shall be held to be in force on proceeding to election, unless the candidate be present or has sent a sufficient excuse in writing.

SEC. 4.—A majority of the legal votes cast Mode of shall be necessary for election; the balloting being continued until such result is obtained in favor of one candidate, and after each ballot the name of the candidate having the lowest number

of votes shall be withdrawn.

SEC. 5.—All vacancies in office shall be imme-vacancies. diately filled in the manner provided for the annual elections; such elections to hold good until the next general election of officers.
