

Laws, and failing to comply with this article of the Constitution within one month after date of his notice of election, such election shall be null and void.

ARTICLE IV.—OFFICERS.

SEC. 1.—The officers of the Association shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Assistant Recording Secretary, and Sergeant-at-Arms; all of whom shall be elected by ballot at the annual meeting. Officers.

SEC. 2.—If only one candidate is nominated for any office, such candidate shall be declared elected by acclamation. Only one nomination.

SEC. 3.—No nomination shall be accepted unless the person nominated shall have signified his willingness to accept the office for which he is named, and no nomination shall be held to be in force on proceeding to election, unless the candidate be present or has sent a sufficient excuse in writing. Nominati'n.

SEC. 4.—A majority of the legal votes cast shall be necessary for election; the balloting being continued until such result is obtained in favor of one candidate, and after each ballot the name of the candidate having the lowest number of votes shall be withdrawn. Mode of election.

SEC. 5.—All vacancies in office shall be immediately filled in the manner provided for the annual elections; such elections to hold good until the next general election of officers. Vacancies.

ARTICLE V.—DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

SEC. 1.—It shall be the duty of the President to direct the calling of all meetings of the Association, and preside thereat; to execute all docu- Duty of President.
