



Ottawa, 9th May, 1919.

Referring to letter to you of the 22nd ultimo and your reply of the 5th instant in regard to the case of Jesse B. Noah who received two loans, one for the purchase of a cow and the other to assist in defraying the cost of a surgical operation, which loans have not been repaid in full; I beg to say in view of the statement submitted, the Department will waive for the present repayment of the said loan, and will allow this man to use the money payable to him this spring in the purchase of seed, but at the same time I may say that the Department relies upon you to see that the Indian makes repayment in full of the amounts due on the loan during the summer in accordance with the promise which he has made.
