

their names at the time of suspension, together with the sum they would have been indebted had they not been suspended.

SEC. 3. It shall be the imperative duty of the President to enforce all penalties on every member who renders himself liable to any of them. unless he is properly excused.

ARTICLE VII.

AMENDMENTS.

No part of these By-Laws shall be repealed, altered or amended, unless a proposal for the same is presented in writing to the Association, at least two weeks previous to action being taken thereon, when if two-thirds of the members present and voting are in favor of the same, it shall be adopted. To meet any peculiar case, however, it shall be in the power of the Association to suspend any Article of these By-Laws, by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting, but such suspension shall not extend beyond the case in which such vote of suspension may be required.
