GREAT FIRE AT MONTREAL.

The Exhibition Buildings Almost Totally
Destroyed—Loss \$150,000—Rebuild-
ing Will Begin at Once.

Montreal, July 30.—The Exhibition
buildings here were almost totally
destroyed by fire this morning at an early
hour. It was shortly after 1 o'clock
that the flames broke out in the power
house of the Montreal Park and Is-
land Railway Company, situated at
the north end of the Exhibition
grounds. The buildings were of very
inflammable material and the flames
spread with great rapidity. When the
first alarm was rung in from box 224
the fire apparatus from the upper part
was then tearing down to the fire on
lower St. Peter-street, and that por-
tion of the city was left without any
protection excepting such as might
be given by the fire brigades of St.
Louis du Mile End and Coteau St.
Louis.

A stiff breeze was blowing from the
northwest, which carried the flames
into the main exhibition building, a
large wooden structure with a glass
roof, in the twinkling of an eye the
whole fabric was one mass of flames.
In the meantime successive alarms
were being sent in. But all the fire ap-
paratus was busily engaged down
town and the gongs in the station
changed out in vain. When the bells
ladders and engines did get started
on their long up-hill run the sky was
brilliantly illuminated and hundreds
of people left their beds to take in
the spectacle.

By the time the first detachment of
firemen reached the scene the power
house of the Montreal Park and Is-
land Railway, the main structure of
the large group of buildings, and the
engine house on the eastern side of the
grounds were reduced to ashes. At
that stage the wind was carrying the
flames down towards Mount Royal-
avenue and the live stock buildings.
The heat from the burning struc-
tures was intense, and the firemen
could not get close enough to do ef-
fective work. At any rate the streams
which were playing on the flames were
insignificant compared with the sea of
fire which they were intended to
cope.

At 2 o'clock a strong northwest wind
was blowing, and the fire was spread-
ing to the sheds and across Mount
Royal-avenue to Machinery Hill and
other buildings. By daybreak the
buildings north of Mount Royal-ave-
nue had been consumed. A quantity
of hose was destroyed and one engine
had to be abandoned to the spreading
flames. The amount of loss has not yet
been ascertained, but it cannot be less
than \$150,000.

Mr. C. C. Stevenson, secretary of the
Exhibition Company, says that the
work of rebuilding will be commenced
immediately, and that an exhibition
will be duly held next September. The
loss to the Park and Island Railway
is placed at \$20,000.
