## IRISH LEADER STRONG FOR WAR ON SIN FEIN

Appeals To Irish Not To  
Neglect Public Opinion  
of America.

BALLISBOROUGH, Ireland, May 26.  
—By the Associated Press.—John Dillon,  
chairman of the Irish Nationalists,  
speaking here today, declared war to  
be the death of the Sinn Fein. The occa-  
sion of his speech was a meeting of  
delegates from East Cavan, to decide  
whether the Nationalist party ought to  
withdraw its candidature and permit the  
Sinn Fein, Arthur Griffith, to be  
elected unopposed.

Mr. Dillon's speech bristled with refer-  
ences to America and appeals to  
Americans not to neglect American public  
opinion. He emphasized his denun-  
ciation of the Sinn Fein by quoting sev-  
eral phrases from his statement recent-  
ly made to the Associated Press, and  
said:

"Some English newspapers have quoted  
the interview I gave to the Associated  
Press of America as evidence that I  
have broken off my alliance with the  
Sinn Fein. You must not break off  
what has never existed."

**O'BRIEN IS SCORNFUL.**  
LONDON, Saturday, May 26.—William  
O'Brien, member of Parliament,  
telegraphed to the newspapers a refer-  
ence to the Sinn Fein revolution.  
"Since the anti-popish plots some  
centuries ago there has been no more  
disgraceful to English statecraft.  
The Irish people will read Lord  
George's story with the same grosser  
indignation and contempt as they felt  
when they read the forged letter pub-  
lished by authors of 'Transatlantic  
Crime.'"

"A similar reaction, even in England,  
is sure to follow. The fact that inter-  
nationalism is the punishment of traitors is  
a sufficient commentary upon the rub-  
bish, shown by the Sinn Fein, in the  
foul means to break up the anti-con-  
scription movement. The German plot  
will turn out to be even grosser than  
the extension of conscription to Ireland."
