TORONTO MAN, OLDEST V. C. IN EMPIRE, DEAD IN LONDON

London, Jan. 29—Sergeant George Richardson, V.C., veteran of the Indian mutiny and the Fenian raids, oldest wearer of the V.C. in the British Empire, died last evening at Westminster military hospital, where he had been a patient for some weeks. The body will be sent to Toronto for interment with military honors.

Sergt. Richardson, who received his decoration in 1859 during the Indian mutiny, was chosen to represent Canada at the burial of the Unknown Soldier in Washington, and laid a wreath from the Dominion on the terms
