#8930 Gnr. W.F.M. Gillies. "A" was on 1-11-26 sentenced by District Court Martial to 90 days' detention and to be put under stoppages of pay until he has made good the sum of \$88.26, for:-

1. Absence without Leave.
2. Losing by neglect his equipment, clothing and Regimental necessaries to the value of \$88.26
3. Conduct to the prejudice of good order and Military discipline, being in possession of articles of clothing the property of persons subject to Military Law.

In arrest from 24-10-26, Sentenced confirmed by D.O.C., M.D.3 on 3-11-26, who mitigates sentence of detention to 60 days. "
