To Publish Life Of Dr. Aggrey

NEW YORK, April 12—A life of the late Dr. J. E. K. Aggrey, entitled "Aggrey of Africa: A Study in Black and White" by Rev. E. W. Smith, is to be published May 1st, in England, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People is informed by the Far and Near Press Bureau.

Dr. Aggrey was born on the Gold Coast, worked 25 years in the Southern States of this country, and returned to West Africa, where he served the Phelps Stokes Educational Commissions in East and West Africa and was appointed Vice-Principal of the Prince of Wales Government College at Achimota, Gold Coast.

Gordon Has a Rival Jumper

Iowa City, Ia., April—What is expected to be a spectacular duel is looked for when Ed Gordon of Iowa and Portmess of Northwestern, both Sophomores, meet in the broad jump.

Gordon came to Iowa from Froebel High School, Gary, Ind. He made the American Olympic team before he had ever experienced college athletic competition. He jumped against Ed Hamm of Georgia Tech, the holder of the world's record and Hamm beat him by a quarter of an inch. Gordon jumped 24 feet 11 3/4 inches.

Portmess is Gordon's keenest rival this year as far as showing in performances this year are concerned. Portmess has done better than 24 ft.
