AMERONGEN, une 24.—News of Germany's decision to accept the peace terms, including the clanses providing for the delivery of the former Ger-man emperor to the allies, reached the castle late yesterday evening. Ex-active how the former emperor was affected by the tidings cannot be as-certainéd, but the attitude of mem-bers of his party give rise to the be-lief that the news was aconsidera-bie shock. When the Associated Press corres-they declared the news was already known at the castle. They made a most scathing criticism of the Ger-man National Assembly for its ac-tion. Evidently they had held to the hope that some way wold be found for the emperor to return to Germany. Now, however, it apparently is real-ized that he is exiled forever from his country.
