108. Every company shall annually prepare returns in Annual re-turns to be accordance with the forms contained in schedule one to this prepared. Act, of its capital, traffic and working expenditure, and of all information required, as indicated in the said form, to be furnished to the Minister; and such returns shall be dated and signed by, and attested upon the oath of the secretary, or some other chief officer of the company, and of the president, or in his absence, of the vice-president or manager of the company:

Every company shall, weekly, prepare returns of its Weekly retraffic for the next preceding seven days, in accordance with turns to be prepared and the form contained in schedule two to this Ast the form contained in schedule two to this Act, and a copy transmitted. of such returns, signed by the officer of the company responsible for the correctness of such return, shall be forwarded by the company to the Minister, within seven days from the day in each week up to which the said returns have been prepared; and another copy of each of such returns, signed by Copy to be the same officer, shall be posted up by the company within posted up. the same delay, and kept posted up for seven days, in some conspicuous place in the most public room in the head office of the company in Canada, and so that the same can be perused
