Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this seventh day of May, 1838, in the Second year of Our Reign.

With these Our Instructions you will receive Governor's Our Commission under the Great Seal of Our Commission. United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, constituting you Our Governor and Commanderin-Chief in and over Our Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies.
