Instructions to Our Trusty and Well-beloved HENRY PRESCOTT, Esquire, Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Our Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies, or in his absence to the Lieutenant-Governor or Officer Administering the Government of Our said Island and its Dependencies for the time being. Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this seventh day of May, 1838, in the Second year of Our Reign.

I.

With these Our Instructions you will receive Our Commission under the Great Seal of Our United Kingdom of *Great Britain and Ireland*, constituting you Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Island of *Newfoundland* and its Dependencies.
