V. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all persons keeping Boarding Houses in either of the Cities of *Quebec* or *Montreal* or Town of *Three-Rivers*, shall from and after the passing of this Act be held to take a License for that purpose, which Licence shall be granted as Licenses for keeping Houses of Public Entertainment are granted, but without any other previous application or certificate than a certificate from any four of six of the nearest neighbours of the applicant, being persons of good moral character and repute, that such applicant is a person of good moral character and repute, and keeps an orderly house and such as is fit and proper for the convenient accommodation of Boarders and Lodgers; and for each and every such License there shall be paid the duty or sum of currency, which shall be paid and deposited in the hands of the Road Treasurer, and be applied as other monies levied by assessment in the said Cities and Town, are usually applied or liable to be applied.

VI. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that such License shall entitle the person keeping such Boarding House to furnish and supply the Boarders or Lodgers therein, but none others, (*bona fide* Guests excepted) with Liquors during meals only, and at no other time, under pain in case of disobedience or contravention of this Act of forfeiting such License, and being thereafter disqualified during the next successive years from obtaining a License or keeping a Boarding House.

VII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no person shall hereafter during this Act keep a Boarding House in either of the said Cities or Town without a License as herein above-mentioned and provided, and every person who shall without having previously obtained such License, keep a Boarding House, shall for each and every such offence incur the penalty of currency.

VIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all persons retailing Ale or Beer, shall in the like manner from and after the passing of this Act and during the same, be held to obtain a License for that purpose, and which shall be granted on a Certificate signed by
