Judge cites defendant's admission, spares him iail term

An Etobicoke man convicted of three impaired driving charges in provincial court Friday escaped a jail sentence because the judge felt the accused man had recognized he was an alcoholic and had tried to deal with his problem.

Judge John Ord told

Lawrence Indovina that on a third impaired conviction he would normally be sentenced to "at least 30 days if not

three months in jail.
"This court takes a different point of view when a man has admitted his problem and taken steps to deal with it. You have perservered as your 36 days under care to seek help in-dicate," Judge Ord said.

Indovina was arrested at 1:38 a.m. Sept. 18 on Dundas Street East while driving with his car headlights off. He registered 1.9 on a breathalyzer. The, legal limit is 0.8.

He was arrested again at 11:49 a.m. the same day on the parking lot of Fieldgate plaze. He registered 2.3 on the breathalyzer.

The third arrest came at 2:24 p.m. Sept. 19 and brought a breathalyzer reading of 1.7.

Indovina lost his driver's license for 18 months on the first offence and was fined \$200 or 30 days in jail on the second. Sentence on the third conviction was postponed until June when results of Indovina's treatment are

Leslie Pallett described as the "contended bender" the accused man was in the psychiatric ward of a Brampton hospital for 11 days and then voluntarily was treated in another program for 25 days. He is a member of the Markland Woods alcoholic's anoymous

It was Indovina's first conviction.

Pallett told the court that

he tried to have Indovina held in custody after he was arrested on the first and arrested on the first and second charges by the Mississauga police. "He was finally kept in the t time," the lawyer said.
