The Minister of the Interior

Sir,

In reference to your letter of the 24th June last, wherein you direct me to hold the money for the Guardians of the woods, I have to inform you that Chief Delisle, required his money, and as those persons are absent, and we could not yet get receipts from them, I accepted a list of the Guardians certified by five Chiefs and gave him the \$119 which you sent me.

I spoke to Mr. Delisle about your letter, and he said he would do every thing in his power to get receipts from the Guardians when they returned.
