Yours of the 5th ultimo, N^o 153,109, acknowledging the receipt of mine of the 30 Augt/94 enclosing an Application from Mr Alfred Shackett to purchase Lots 12 and 17, Can 7, E.B.R. St Edmund; and in reply I have to inform you that you may authorize a Forest Bailiff to examine and value these Lots, provided the cost of such examination is paid in advance. Received.

In reply I have the honor to say - That the Applicant made a mistake in the number of one of the Lots - it should have been Lot 14, Can 7, E.B.R. and not Lot 12, as he entered in his Application, and so he requested to have it changed to Lot 14, Can 7, E.B.R. St Edmund.

I send herewith the Forest Bailiff's report on said valuation of Lots 12 and 17, Can 7, E.B.R. St Edmund, the value placed on Lot 14 is the sum of \$20.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Cash and on Lot 17, Can 7, E.B.R. the sum of 35.00 Cash
