## Premier Oliver Urges a Reciprocal Tariff With Australia

VICTORIA, Jan. 28.—Premier Oliver moved today to protect British Columbia's interests in the proposed new reciprocal tariff agreement which will be negotiated between the Canadian and Australian governments during the next few days. The premier sent a long telegram to Hon. T. A. Low, Canadian minister of trade and commerce, asking him to see that British Columbia products are fully covered in the proposed tariff pact. He urged particularly that Australia grant British Columbia lumber and fruit a tariff preference.

Senator Wilson, representing Premier Bruce of Australia, will reach Ottawa shortly to negotiate a new tariff agreement between the two dominions.
