

sub-section 6, by which it is provided that the Chief or Chiefs may frame, subject to confirmation by the Governor General in Council, rules and regulations for inter alia the construction and maintenance of water courses, Roads, Bridges, Ditches and Fences.

You will be good enough to summon a Council of the Chief, and bring the important subject of establishing proper line fences between, not only the holdings of White men on adjoining farms and their own lands, but also between the different Indian farms on the Reserve; and request them to draw up rules and regulations under the provisions of the Act before referred to, and in respect to which rules and regulations
