



Ottawa 4th November, 1904.

Sir,

I beg to inform you that on the 4th August last Alexander Tanner (who wrote from the Crooked Lake Agency, Broadview) informed the Department that he desired to draw all his funded money for the purpose of buying cattle, and a team of good working horses. He stated that he wished to begin work for himself. The enclosed reply dated the 2nd September was sent to him addressed to Broadview. It has been returned to the Department not having been delivered. If you know where Tanner is — I shall be glad if you will send him the letter, and also that you will make a report in the case.
