Right Reverend Sir:

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Lordship's communication of the 12th ultimo in reference to a new pump for the Carcross Indian Boarding School.

In reply I beg to say that Your Lordship is hereby authorized to purchase a Challenge type, double acting, brass lined and with packed plunger, such as recommended by Mr. Johnson of the school staff. Your Lordship may also purchase a supply of packing, a good strainer and foot valve. The amount for these should be forwarded to the Department by Your Lordship, certified in the usual way and it should be in duplicate. This purchase should be made through Mr. Matthew Watson, Carcross.
