Madam,-

Although you were not among the teachers attending the summer course at the Ontario Agricultural College to whom the Department promised an increase in salary to help to pay the cost of the course, your action in taking this course is appreciated and if you are to remain in the Indian school work and will forward a certificate to that effect from the Principal of the Industrial School or Superintendent of the Roman Catholic Missions, the Department is prepared to make you a grant of twenty-five dollars if you have successfully completed the course of the College. Should it, however, not be your intention at the present time to continue in the Indian school work but should you take it up again at a future date the Department will then be prepared to make this grant on those terms. We should be pleased to hear from you at your earliest convenience.
