Ottawa, July 11, 1919.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of a return showing the attendance of Indian children at the white school at River Hebert, Cumberland County, Nova Scotia, for the year ending June 30, 1919.

In connection therewith I beg to say that this is the first return received showing Indian children in attendance at this school. The Department will allow payment of a tuition grant at the same rate as is paid for Indian children at the White school at Springhill Junction, namely, fifty cents a month per pupil on the average attendance. A cheque for the amount due will be sent as soon as you inform the Department to whom the same should be made payable, whether to the teacher or the Secretary treasurer of the School Board. Kindly supply this information as soon as possible when a cheque for the amount due will be sent.

I may say that you should have given this information when forwarding the return, and when forwarding any future returns from white schools in your agency this information should be given by you.
