The Council decided to ask the Department of Indian Affairs to make necessary arrangement as soon as possible so that the people of the Sice Rations may get Geed for their Cattle and Horses as some are already starving. Seed Grain, and Provision, on their fall interest money at the rate of \$3.00 per head by way of orders, to be issued by the Visiting Supt. and the Speaker is hereby appointed and authorized to go up to Brantford and announce this decision to the Visiting Suft to avoid any delay on the part of the Council.
