

A French Jack, An enemy's fleet.

A Blue Pendant under French Pendant, An enemy's ship.

A Red Pendant under ditto, An enemy's brig.

A White Pendant under ditto, An enemy's sloop or schooner.

A Union Jack over either of the enemy's signals, means that the vessels are in in our possession.

When a vessel requires assistance, a ball will be hoisted at the mast-head with the descriptive colors.

N. B. The only mixed colors used to describe Vessels are a Red pierced White, a French Jack, and French Pendant; therefore when any other mixed colors are flying on the Citadel Hill, the signals have a private meaning, and are not for vessels.
