Grant us unfeigned repentance for our paſt tranſgreſſions, and for our forgetfulneſs of thy ſovereign dominion; and fill us with lively gratitude for thy forbearance in the exerciſe of that dominion towards us; ſo that we may become fit ſubjects of thy future mercies; through Jeſus Chriſt our Lord. *Amen.*
