- No. 5.—Corner of Wellington and Dundas streets. Keys at McCormick's Confectionery and Lloyd's Hotel.
- No. 6.—Corner of Kent and Talbot streets. Keys at Mr. Charles Hammond's and Ald. Pritchard's.
- No. 7.—Corner of Sydenham and Richmond streets. Keys at Ald. Egan's, Mr. Hyman's, Mr. Peel's and Mr. Reid's residences.
- No. 8.—Corner of Waterloo and Piccadilly streets. Keys at Ald. Christie's and Carling's old Brewery.
- No. 12.—Corner of Bond and Colborne streets. Keys at Minchin's store and Mr. McBride's residence.
- No. 13.—Corner of Dundas and Maitland streets. Keys at Bullivant's and Webster's stores.
- No. 14.—Corner of Maitland and Simcoe streets. Key at Mrs. Noon's store.
- No. 15.—Corner of Wellington and Simcoe streets. Key at R. Coote's store.
- No. 16.—Corner of Horton and Talbot streets. Keys at Col. Moffat's, Gas Works and Mr. Overell's house.
- No. 17.—Corner of York and Ridout streets. Key at John Campbell's house.
- No. 21.—Clarence street and G. W. R. Keys at Thornton's and Green's lumber yard.
- No. 23.—Corner of Burwell and York streets. Keys at D. Lester's and No. 4 Police Station.
- No. 24.—Corner of Litchfield and Raglan streets. Keys at No. 3 Police Station and Mr. Chenery's house.
