In Liverpool they have, besides Missionary Priests, a set of men called Pastors, Fathers of the Church, Christian Brothers; of women, Sisters of Mercy, Sisters of the Holy Child, Sisters of Charity of St. Paul, Sisters of the Holy Family, Sisters of the Good Shepherd, and Sisters of Charity, besides Schools and Institutions.

And in Scotland, at Edinburgh, Glasgow, Dundee and Aberdeen, as the great centre of influence, they have planted orders of various kinds. In Edinburgh alone, the whole missionary operations of the Church of Rome have been handed over to Jesuits.

It, then, the Church of Rome has such a vast machinery in the northern part of the country, added to a vast machinery in England, and a vast one in Ireland, all combining and united for the overthrow of Protestantism in Britain; if the mass of our population be in such a state as to be influenced more by evil than good, and if there be an utter want of confidence in public men, in consequence of their want of principle...
