SARAH EXPLAINS

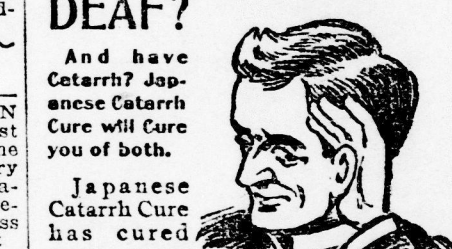
Did Not Say That Canadians Were From Iroquois.

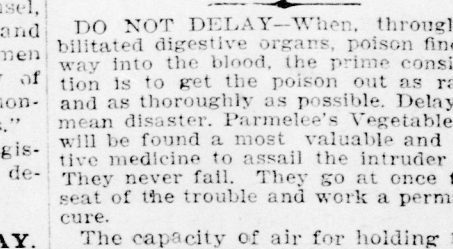
