SPECIAL PRAYERS FOR THE MEN
Church of England Is Planning a Big Movement Beginning November 29th.

A prayer movement for men will be inaugurated in the Church of England during the week commencing Nov. 29. During the annual session of the general synod, held in Ottawa in September last, a message was received from the House of Bishops in the lower house, asking that the first week of Advent, beginning with Nov. 29, be set apart as a week of supplication for the extension of Christ's kingdom in the earth.

The message was received by the clergy and laity that the week should be observed as a week of prayer.

It is significant that the efforts made by the great conference in Lambeth to extend Christ's kingdom in the earth are being taken up by the Canadian church.

Special Sermons.
"In this diocese," said Rev. Dyson Hague, "special sermons will be preached and meetings will be held especially for men. Some of the clergymen will hold special prayer meetings. It is expected that St. Andrew's Brotherhood, a leading organization of the men of the church for the extension of the kingdom, will take a leading part in this movement and its practical accomplishment."

This series of meetings will mark the end of the first quarter century of the organization of St. Andrew's Brotherhood. It was founded in 1883 in St. James' Church, Chicago, by twelve young men who formed a Bible class.

Two Rules.
It has two rules as follows:
First, that its members shall pray daily for the spread of Christ's kingdom; and second, that they shall make at least one earnest effort each week to bring some young man within the hearing of the gospel.

Since that time its growth has been rapid. It has spread all over England, United States, Canada and other countries. National councils have been established in every country. In Canada the council is composed of 36 members with two travelling secretaries, Mr. F. W. Thomas in the east, and Mr. J. A. Birmingham in the west.

There will be no separate demonstration to mark the first 25 years' work. The organization will join in the work with the church in the extension of the kingdom.
