Libel Action Against Montreal

Star Concluded—Verdict
for \$5,000.

The readers of the Graphic will remember a few months ago, the Montreal Star published a letter which simply bore the signature "X", and which connected the name of the Honorable John Hall Kelly, of New Carls with the activities of the German Agent, Von gel and Ambassador Bernstoff.

The Graphic got in touch with the Honourable Mr. Kelly at the time, and he denied having any knowledge of anything whatsoever contained in said letter.

Immediately following this week, he sued the Montreal Daily Star for libel, claiming that he knew absolutely nothing about the contents of the said letter, that it was false and untrue, and constituted a libel against him.
