### SALE OF GAS STOCK.

At the request of the Ontario Gas Company, one hundred thousand dollars worth of new stock in the company which supplies light to Toronto was sold at public auction yesterday afternoon at an average price of 188, which is three points above the market.

When at noon Auctioneer Dickson mounted his stand the room was filled with moneyed men. Alexander Manning, H. C. Hammond, James A. King, Robert H. Miles, H. M. Pittman, A. Ford, T. R. Wood, A. E. Ames, G. A. Alexander, J. H. Fraser, John Stark, T. E. Fraser, W. J. Baines, Thomas Long and many others were there. The price realized was much higher than was expected, C. C. Baines having a number of orders to buy at 175 and 185. The lowest that was paid was 180 1/2, for which H. C. Hammond purchased 50 shares and the highest 198 1/2, which A. E. Ames paid for ten shares.

Auctioneer Dickson announced that the stock would be sold in lots of 10 shares each and asked for bids. One hundred and seventy was the first bid, and was promptly raised into 180 by C. C. Baines, who was the first to bid. The stock was then sold in lots of 10 shares each, with another raise and bought 30 more shares at 187 1/2. He had to pay 181 for the next 20. C. C. Baines bought 100 shares for the same figure. In a short time 183 was reached, at which point the Ontario Gas Co. bought 50 shares. Mr. Hammond got on board again, and bought 50 shares at 183, and 50 shares at 184. C. C. Baines got 50 shares at 185, and 50 shares at 186. Mr. Hammond got 50 shares at 187, and 50 shares at 188. C. C. Baines got 50 shares at 189, and 50 shares at 190. The sale was a most successful one, and the 3000 shares were all gone at 184 1/2.
