

Egg Basket Burglars

Here are some of the things that are ight to expect from your hens: ut among them.

2nd. A thin or broken roof. The nens always roost up close to the roof of the poultry house, and if this is thin, they will be uncomfortable in old weather, and during rainy, spells will get wet at night. Uncomfortable ouses are sure to rob the egg basket. 3rd. Parasites of different kinds. hese take the vitality from the hens, using them to cease laving. A henuse should be kept free from these y a liberal use of whitewash and arbolic acid.

4th. Too much sloppy food and a ack of gravel and grain check the hens in their laving, Plenty of grit and shell producing food becomes essential to the filling of the egg basket. 5th. Poor ventilation of the hen louse. Foul air is about as harmful o hens as a very cold atmosphere. SHORT KINGS.
