## Other APEC Business Tools

APEC has developed several tools supplementing the IAP and making it easier to do business in the Asia-Pacific region. The BizAPEC (www.bizapec. com) serves as a "one-stop shop" for information on all various aspects of doing business in the region. The site includes industry information by sector, comparing export markets, laws, regulations and requirements for doing business in APEC markets, as well as advice, training and business opportunities for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs).

APEC has also developed guidelines on business travel, customs, e-commerce and paperless trading. Market information has been made more accessible through resources such as the APEC Tariff Database, the APEC Investment Guidebook, the APEC Ports Database and the Rules of Origin Compendium, which can be downloaded from www.upecsec.org.sg/business\_center/service\_business/service\_biz.html.
