Ferry de Kerckhove (B.Soc.Sc. Honours [Economics], M.A. [Political Science], University of Ottawa) joined the Department of External Affairs in 1973 after having been a military officer and a researcher at the Centre québécois de relations internationales.

Mr. de Kerckhove has held various positions at the Canadian Embassy in Tehran and at the Canadian Delegation to NATO in Brussels. His last position in Ottawa before being assigned to Moscow in 1992 was as a Director in the Economic Policy Bureau, from 1989 to 1991.
