The Prime Minister has articulated seven principles on which the future of our constitutional development will be found. The first is that any change should lead to a more prosperous Canada. The second is to promote constitutional change that makes us more efficient and competitive as a country. The third principle is fairness as a nation to show respect for the equality of our citizens and the diversity of our citizens. The fourth is to avoid stale dogma or tired ideology. Now is the time for innovation. The fifth is the need to maintain national standards in the interest of all Canadians. The sixth is to consider any and all arrangements that have an effect of moving decision making closer to the people. Lastly, the rights of all Canadians must be safeguarded.

Those are seven powerful principles for the future of our Constitution and we must not settle for less.
