With reference to the above department I have decided to recommend to the Board of Governors,-That Professor D. A. Murray be confirmed in the Chairmanship of the Department; (2) That Dr. Sullivan be advanced to a full professorship. I have informed Dr. Murray. Dr. Sullivan and Professor Gillson of these changes. The latter gave his warm approval to them. To him I gave the assurance that his claims for a full professorship would be sympathetically considered at the earliest possible date. You will note that I have not nominated anyone the Redpath Professor of Pure Mathematics.
