XVI.—ALTERATION OF RULES.

Rules may be altered or amended at the Annual General Meeting, or a Special General Meeting called for that purpose, and not otherwise, provided that one month's notice of the proposed alteration shall have been given in writing to the Secretary and posted in the rooms of the Institute.

XVII.—MISCONDUCT OF A MEMBER.

Any member may be suspended by the Committee (five to form a quorum) for any act on his part which may be deemed unbefitting an officer, or as calculated to bring discredit on the Institute, and such member shall forseit all rights as a member from the date. He may be re-instated by the Committee upon offering satisfactory explanations.
