

- body, N.** ö'gwliné, H. ökona' (*only surface of body*) ; H. k'w'maqñ'-otlina, *left side*; hal'itkoltna, *right side* ; tlöqoanna'la, *sick, sore all over*.
body, corpus, H. k'w'lkuis; k'a'lkué, *drifting* (—é, *on surface of water*) ; k'w'lkuuntis (—unts, (?) ; —ls, *in sea*).
to boil, v. n., L. thema', H. thema', tlö'lm.
to bolt, N. ts'k'lm'k'ca.
bone, L. W. G. qñl; L. hák'ö'pol, sternum (—pôé, *breast*) ; H. ts'lö'pon, sternum (—poa, *breast*) ; k'ö'tsuqñ'ca, collarbone (—qñna, neck).
— *of fish*, L. k'ö'k'cajö.
boom (of canoe sail), L. tsö'kyinü'. themé (—dütlemé, *side of*), N. ts'kyanqal'.
born (perhaps : from beginning), N. nü'tlamö, *born a fool* (nü'tlem, *fool*) ; nö'k'amö, *born wise*, (nö'k'at, *wise*).
both, N. H. waqs; N. waqse'ñqé, *both sides* (—ñqé, *edge*) ; waqsem-gillis, *somebody on each side of an object on beach*; waqsemk'a'ska, *to put into mouth from both sides*; waqsistant, *to divide*; H. waqsöde'ton, *both ears* (—eton, *ear*).
bottle made of kelp, kelp, L. N. H. wä'wnté.
bottom of an object, N. ö'qsté, —qste ; L. pö'lqsté, *anus*; sñ'qstné, *blanket tied around belly*; H. —sté (?); kyä'qté, *notch of arrow* (=*notch in bottom*); sap'ñqsté-gylla, *blanket tied around belly*.
bottom of sea, N. k'utsi's (—ls, *in water*), H. wñ'yu'nk'äpois, (—unk', *edge* ; —unk, *under* ; —ls, *in water*).
bowl, L. N. tlä'kuis, H. G. tlë'kuis.
boustring, H. tlkuë'tskm.
bore of canoe, H. tlë'tskina.
— *man in bore of canoe*, N. ö'kyliné.
box, Indian, L. qk'tskm (*borrowed from Çatlölg*), L. N. H. gyü'litas.
box for blankets, H. pák öye'la, G. ják'en'la.
— — *grease, H.* tñnguá'(sé (=atsé, *receptacle*)).
— — *blankets, H.* ky'ñlqsem'at-sé (= *white blanket receptacle*).
— — *woman's working box, H.* okwal-ñtë (= —atsé, *receptacle*).
— — *for berries, A.* k'ntlk'.
boy, L. N. gyinä'num, (*child*), H. gäpüö' (*about twelve years old*).
bracelet of mountain goat horn, N. yö'k'wékila, L. gy'ö'k'ula.
bracelet of copper, Tl. k'ö'k'ö'k'öé, H. ts'ewñ'ta.
braid, L. haë'qstö, L. k'ñ'lleé.
brain, L. tlë'k'ra, H. tlqlk'öa'tsa.
branch, L. wñ'tlsñ'ñü, H. t'ësm'.
to break, L. kyü'q'uit (see *Ts'flight*), N. kyö'k'ca, kyö'qkyö'k'om'la, *noise of breaking* (—ala, *noise*); H. kõu'meslü; kõ'kunsha, *to break to pieces (reduplicated)*; kõkon-pa'lit, *to break by bending*; kõpnqtlä'ut, — *off hind part* (—qtlä', *hind part*); koö'impüüt, — *off point*.
— *with hammer, H.* mu'qslut,
— *with one stroke*; mumu'qsiia, *with many strokes*.
— *coppers in potlatch, Tl.* lñq's'E'nt; Lñ'lnq's'E'nt'alö, *means of breaking copper (a name)*.
