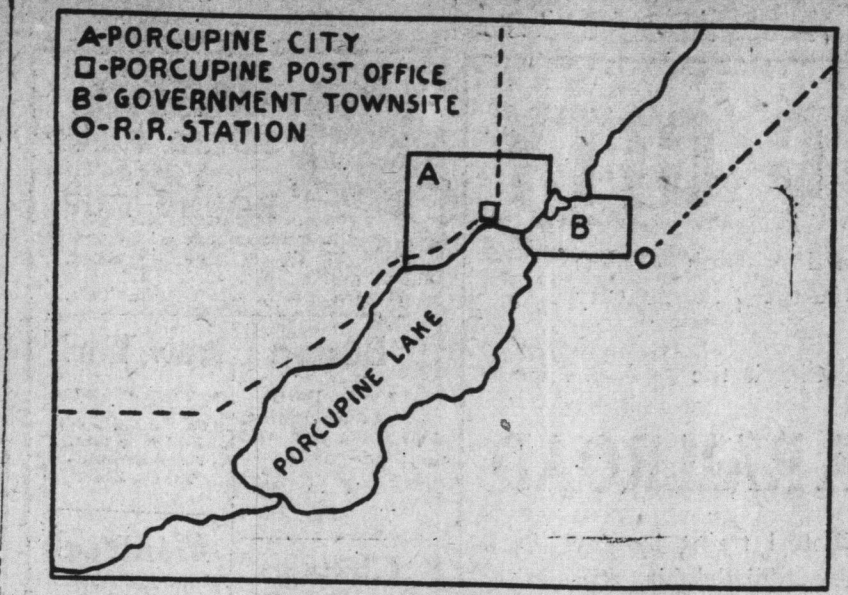
PORCUPINE GOLD MINES

BOARD OF TRADE EASILY  
PASSES THOUSAND MARK

Membership Campaign Ends in Shower of Congratulations on Brilliant Success.

The board of trade wound up its whirlwind membership campaign on Saturday with luncheon at National Club at 1 p.m., and final figures showing 1029 new members added in 10 days period were greeted with enthusiasm.

The board has now 2500 members, comparing with 800 in 1908. Mr. W. P. Gundy occupied the chair, flanked by President R. S. Gourlay, the acting secretary F. D. Tolchard, vice-president G. T. Somers, and other members of the executive.

After the lunch Mr. Gundy briefly asked the captains for reports. Every one was ready, but as Lloyd Wood, who has the dentists in charge, and Eric Armour, who has the lawyers, doctors, professors and teachers to look after, asked for an extension of time, it was decided to receive applications up to Saturday next. Every announcement was greeted with applause, especially when the leading figures were announced. Mr. C. H. Wilson, who had electrical contractors, fixtures and supplies, and jewellers, making a total of one hundred and ten, Mr. Gundy rose and called for cheers, which were heartily given.

The Dead Accomplished.

A grand total of 1029 actual applications was announced, making the membership of the board over 2500. The principal figures given in were: No. 2, lawyers and doctors, Eric Armour, captain, 87, No. 5 bookbinders, bookkeepers, engravers, etc., Captain S. B. Gundy, 81, No. 3 builders and contractors, lumber and timber, Captains Eric-Mayor Oliver and Hugh Munro, 83; No. 12 electrical contractors, Mr. Tolchard, the acting secretary in the absence of Mr. F. G. Morley, the meeting was brought to a conclusion.

Twelve Hundred May Be Total.

Mr. Gundy spoke enthusiastically of the grand work achieved by the board, whose task and skill would lead to greater things. He pointed out that the ten hundred and twenty-nine did not include thirty-nine names handed in to the board just before the campaign commenced. Before the end of next week the number would be swollen to twelve hundred.

Praise for the Press.

Vice-President Somers said he was bubbling over with enthusiasm. He wished to thank the press for its splendid work. They had now a greater board of trade than has been in 1908. They had 800 members, in 1909, 950, in 1910, 1450, and now, early in the fourth month of 1911, they had upwards of 2500 good men and true pledged to accomplish wonders for the future of Toronto. They were building up a great city and he would not be surprised if in 12 years they had a million people in Toronto.

Mr. Harris wished to speak of a valuable ally. He referred to the press, which in this case had been unique in its unanimity and solidarity.

He wished to move a vote of thanks to the press for the service it had rendered the board of trade.

Dr. Emory seconded the motion, which was carried with acclamation.

Mr. Hayward had nothing but good to say for the board. He would like to see the name changed to "Chamber of Commerce."

Gave Mr. Gundy Credit.

After brief speeches by Messrs. Hynes and Wilson, Mr. Gourlay called for cheers for their chief, Mr. W. P. Gundy, of whom they had every reason to be proud. To him many belonged the great honor of success. Mr. Gundy modestly suggested that it was due to the captains the honor was due.

Mr. W. Douglas, speaking for the captains, said they were proud to have taken a share in the campaign.

Mr. Piers, formerly of Montreal, added his quota to the paean of praise.
