BUSINESS AHEAD OF LAST YEAR.

The trade distribution at Montreal, taken as a whole, is of a very fair seasonable character, with most houses the volume of trade being a good deal ahead of last year. In general dry-goods, and kindred lines, business may be called good. The citrus complain that retail business is suffering somewhat from the continued open weather, but country retail orders, both from travellers and by mail, are coming in in goodly number. In pig iron, firm prices are maintained, but there is no great activity, and the general report regarding remittances in values. Cements are moving freely, and prices are firmer, owing to advance in freight, and the scarcity of freight space, so that some shortness of supply is anticipated. However, good for the usual stock-taking, so that a very heavy buying of leather is reported. Values in this latter goods, but the sorting is not so good as last year.
