FEW DAYS GRACE BEING ALLOWED M.S.A. BREAKERS

No Intention of Law Enforcement of Police Chiefs. NO DEFIANCE TOLERATED Speedy Arrests for Any Who Openly Defy Service Act.

That all men in class 1 who have not signed a claim for exemption sheet or a report for service form are being given every opportunity to surrender themselves as defaulters, and still get a chance, is indicated by a circular issued by the chief of police of the Dominion of Canada.

The attention of the chiefs is called to the fact that under the military service act they are empowered to arrest for a few days at least, a man who has failed to comply with the act. The reason why nothing so far has been done in this regard is known to be because of the Government's desire to grant "a few days grace" and give every man who has not yet signed a not to wait until he is arrested, as he will then be classed as a deserter.

The circular instructs the chiefs that their duty is to act, but not to wait for a few days at least. It instructs the chiefs to act without delay and arrest immediately any man who is known to be hoarding of the fact that he has not signed.

If Deputy Registrar Wisner on the other hand, in the case of a man who is arrested without further ceremony, it means that the act is not being enforced in a lax manner. It simply means that a few days grace is being allowed before more drastic measures are put into effect.

The circular closes by saying that further and more general instructions will be sent out to the chiefs of police in a few days.

No provision is made yet for policemen, civil or military, to approach men and ask them to produce their receipts. This will come, it is thought, in the next circular.
