SIXTY THOUSAND A YEAR.

The Allan Line Makes a Record Carrying Immigrants.

London, Jan. 1.—During the past year the Allan Line carried 58,353 emigrants to Canada, which constitutes a record, being 821 more than the previous year.

SAVED GIRL, LOST OWN LIFE. SERGT. FLETCHER DROWNED.

First Skating Fatality of the Season in Burlington Bay—Miss Gray's Narrow Escape.

Hamilton, Jan. 1.—(Special.)—Thomas Arthur Fletcher, 161 Elgin-street, a clerk in Balfour & Co's office, gave his life Saturday afternoon to save the life of his daughter, Miss Gray, 18 South Wellington-street, a bookkeeper employed by the Wright Hat Company.

They started out in the afternoon to skate across the bay to the Brant House. About a mile from the hotel they skated on a piece of rotten ice and both went thru. Fletcher helped Miss Gray out, and she made her narrow escape to the shore. Fletcher never coming to the surface again until his body was recovered at noon today.

Miss Gray had a terrible experience before she got to the shore. She fell into another hole while trying to make her way to the shore. Walter Filman, who saves the man, ran from the shore, and after great difficulty rescued her. Both were so exhausted that they became unconscious, and had to be helped to land by Filman's father.

The news of the drowning will not reach the city till a late hour last night, when it was too late to make any effort to recover Fletcher's body, which was not taken out of the water until today at noon. Fletcher was manager of the Junior Tigers this year and had played with the team for several years. He was a color sergeant in F Co, 12th Regiment, and president of the Sergeant's Mess. He was 22 years of age.

JUDGE ROSS PASSES AWAY AT THE AGE OF NINETY-ONE.

Former Partner of Hon. R. W. Scott Dies at His Ottawa Home Saturday.

Ottawa, Dec. 31.—(Special.)—Judge William Aldred Ross died this afternoon at his home here. He was 91 years of age and had been in declining health for some time. Previous to being called to the bar in 1876, he practised law as a partner of the Hon. R. W. Scott. He retired from the bench just seven years ago, and was succeeded by his widow, whom he married in September, 1900. He is one of our civil engineers, Ottawa.

DONALD MCGAGGART TAKES HIS LIFE. Well-Known Landowner Despondent Because of Ill Health.

Almost at the completion of a trip for his health and seemingly cured of the nervous disease which afflicted him, Donald McGaggart of Lorneville committed suicide by poisoning himself evening. A fit of melancholy, as a result of nervous prostration, is given as a reason for the deed.

Mr. McGaggart is a man of about 40 years of age and is widely known and well related in London. Some time ago he went on a trip for his health, in company with his son, who was stopped at Toronto on the home trip and registered at the Tremont House. Yesterday Mr. McGaggart complained of the noise and rooms were taken at 188 Jarvis-street. The son left his father after dining on Saturday afternoon, and returning at 6 p.m. found him lying on the bed in the agony of carbolic acid poisoning.

The sufferer was hurried to St. Michael's Hospital, where he died in a short time.

ANARCHY IN MOROCCO. British Subjects Living in Tangier Warned to Safety.

Tangier, Morocco, Dec. 31.—Completing anarchy reigns in Tangier district and in the country generally. This is conclusively shown by the reports from different points during last week. The British consuls requested the British authorities living in the consular district to be informed as to the government's inability to be responsible for the safety of life or property.

A number of outrages had occurred within a two-mile radius of Tangier. A house belonging to the late President John Drummond Hay, who was British minister to Morocco, has been completely looted, notwithstanding the presence of a guard. The family was absent and unfortunates do not know exactly what the cause was.

The Moroccan government admits its inability to control the situation, and has asked the British government to express the opinion that France should take immediate steps to restore order. The British government has expressed its sympathy for the Moroccan government, but has declined to undertake any such step.
