
James A. Campbell.

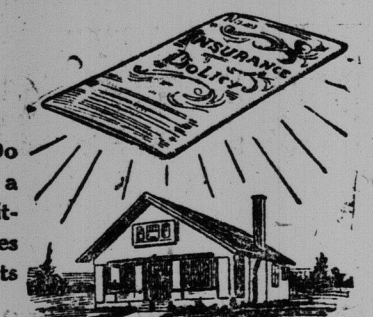
