Toronto, July 29.—The dominion parliament of the Great War Veterans is being held in Toronto today. Returned men from the Atlantic to the Pacific are represented by 200 delegates who are assembled here. The feature of today's proceedings was the address of Colonel W. H. Purdy of Halifax, who strongly criticized the "unreasonable attitude of some of the members who were losing public sympathy."

The secretary's report states that at the birth of the organization there were only twenty-seven branches and a total membership of 3,584, in the whole of the dominion. Their membership now numbers 25,000, though not all are in good standing. The number of branches in each province are as follows: Ontario, 65; Saskatchewan, 15; British Columbia, 16; Alberta, eight; Manitoba, five; Quebec, six; New Brunswick, seven; Nova Scotia, eight; Prince Edward Island, one.
