

NEWSPAPER MAN RECEIVES HONOR

Quebec, April 14.—Official information was received here today from the Baron of Vitrolles, French general consul in Montreal, to the effect that Henri Gagnon, managing director of "Le Soleil" and director of the Canadian Press, has been honored by the French government by being named an officer of the French Academy. The French government very seldom awards this decoration, which includes the Academic Palms, and it is much envied. It is the first time in the last 10 years that such an honor has been extended to a Canadian.

PRINCE WILL NOT COME THIS YEAR


London, April 14.—"There is not the slightest possible chance that the Prince of Wales will visit Canada during the present year."


