REGULATIONS FOR DEGREE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY.

lat.—No one shall be admitted to the Degree of Doctor of Medicine and Master of Surgery, who shall not have attended lectures for a period of at least four years subsequently to the date of passing his Matriculation Examination, in this College, or some other University, College, or School of Medicine approved by this College; (a certificate from his tuter or tutors that the applicant has been one year studying Medicine in the office of one or more registered Medical Practitioners will be received in lice. of one of the four years o study—but in any case three years additional study, either in this or some other approved School of Medicine will be required.

2nd.—Candidates for the Final Examination shall furnish testimonials of attendance on the following branches of Medical education, viz.

Provided, however, that testimonials equivalent to, though not precisely the same as those above stated, may be presented and accepted.

Srd.—The candidate must also give proof by ticket of having attended during twelve monahs the practice of the Provincial and City Hospital, or that of some other hospital approved by this College; and also a cartificate of having three months practice in dispussing drags.

ith.—He must give proof by third of hardin estanted for at least six months the practice of a lying-in happinel, approved of the the Callege, or of having attended at least six comes of accombinent; also a certificate from a registered Medical Practitiones, of "Professory in the Practice of Vaccination.
