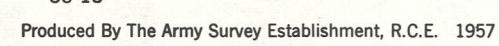

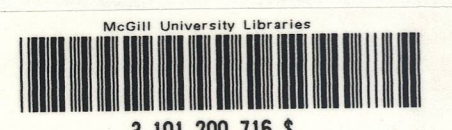
This map was compared with aerial photography flown in 1976 and found to be up-to-date in all major features.
