Paris, May 7.—The king of Spain, Alfonso XIII, arrived in Paris this morning for a two days' official visit. President Raymond Poincaré and Premier Louis Barthou, with all the members of the French cabinet, were present to receive the royal party at the station. The king and queen, who are accompanied by their children, will remain in Paris until the 10th inst. The king is expected to leave for the city of Lyons on the 10th inst. and to return to Madrid on the 12th inst. The British ambassador, Lord Curzon, was formally introduced to President Wilson at the White House yesterday. The president and the ambassador had a long and friendly conversation. The ambassador is expected to remain in Washington for some time.
