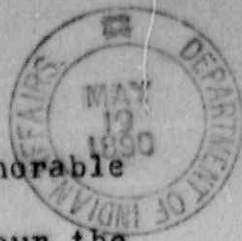


Copy of a Report of a Committee of the Honourable
the Executive Council, approved by His Honour the
Lieutenant Governor on the 15th day of April, 1890.



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On a memorandum from the Honourable the Attorney General, dated 8th April, 1890, stating that he has had under consideration a copy of a despatch from the Honourable the Secretary of State for Canada, enclosing copy of an approved Minute of Council, dated 13th January, 1890, having reference to the reported action of one Louis, an Indian, employed as Constable by the Stipendiary Magistrate on the Upper Skeena, and the report of Captain Fitzstubbs, the Magistrate alluded to, thereupon and recommending that a copy of the report furnished by Captain Fitzstubbs be forwarded to the Honourable the Secretary of State for Canada.
